

# NCC 2017 FEE SCHEDULE

## ENROLMENT FEES

Registration Fee	Payable per family	\$100.00
Confirmation Fee	Payable per student (maximum of \$500 per family)	\$250.00

## TUITION FEES (Per Term - 4 Terms/Year)

Tuition fees and levies are billed each Term and are payable by the first day of Term, unless a payment arrangement is in place with the Business Office. A 3% discount applies to the tuition component of fees, if payment is made in full, for the whole year, by the first day of Term 1. No whole year discounts are available for concessional/discounted fees or for credit card payments.

## PAYMENT OPTIONS

1. Term fee payment to be made in full by the first day of each Term unless a payment plan has been made with the College prior to the commencement of Term.
2. An automatic payment schedule arranged with the College (e.g. direct debit payments).
3. Self managed direct debits from your bank account.

Payments can be made at the Business Office Monday to Friday from 8:00am to 4:30pm. Cash, cheque, credit card (1% fee charged for credit card) or debit card are accepted.

1. A place on the bus is subject to availability of seats. Seating priority will be given to full time users.
2. No refunds will be given for days when children do not use the bus, including Year 12 students who do not use the bus at the end of Term 4.
3. There are three options with respect to the use of the College buses - full time (as per above schedule), AM only (60% of full time rate), PM only (60% of full time rate).
4. A fee of \$20 will be charged when parents make more than one change to bus arrangements per year.

## INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC PROGRAM

- **Music Program** - music tuition will be billed along with Tuition Fees each Term. Please note: Term 1 music tuition will be billed in March.
- **Instrument Hire** - invoiced separately and only to students participating in the Program.

## STUDENT ACCIDENT PROTECTION PLAN

This accident protection plan gives 24 hour-a-day, worldwide coverage to all full-time students at Nambour Christian College. For further information, contact Reception for an information brochure.

## CHARGES IN LIEU OF NOTICE

When a parent wishes to withdraw a child/children from the College, a minimum of 30 days notice in writing addressed to the Registrar is required. Otherwise one month's fees in lieu of notice will be charged. Any credit relating to Bus Charges will be calculated on a pro-rata basis.

## WORKING BEE LEVY

Funds raised from the Working Bee Levy are used to maintain the grounds for the benefit of all students. In lieu of paying the Levy, parents may opt to work voluntary hours for the College.

## BUILDING FUND

Donations to the Building Fund are tax deductible and may include gifts of \$2 or more, property (purchased within 12 months of gifting) and trading stock. Donations to the building fund are sought to cover the cost of providing facilities for the use of students.

## LIBRARY FUND

Donations made to the Library Fund will be used to resource our Library. These donations are tax deductible and may include gifts over \$2, property (purchased within 12 months of the gift), trading stock, cultural gifts and cultural bequests.

## OUTDOOR EDUCATION CAMPS

The Outdoor Education Program at NCC continues to provide a diversity of activities and experiences during a student's time at the College to enhance their life skills and social interactions. However, the cost of venues and facilitators continues to rise sharply, due mostly to indemnity insurance costs for these external organisations. Therefore, parents are asked to contribute to the cost of their child attending a school camp.

- **Primary School:** Primary School Camps are not included in fees and will not be charged to your fee account. Allow \$60 for Years 1 and 2, \$110 for Years 3 and \$220-\$280 for Years 4 to 6. These fees are payable before camp dates, as advised.
- **Middle & Senior School:** A proportion of camp fees are included in Tuition Fees. However, please allow a contribution of between \$210 to \$395 for Years 7, 8, 9, 11 and 12 and \$750 to \$850 for Year 10. These fees are payable before camp dates as advised.
